After May 5, 2014, registration fees for delegates and ISGG members will be increased by € 25.

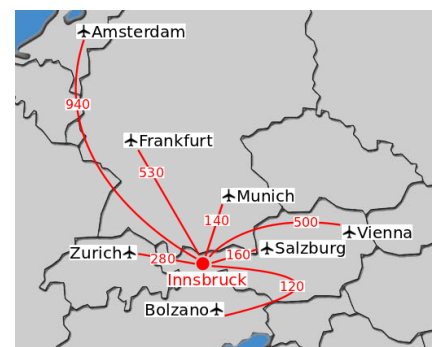
## Presentation and Proceedings
